

## Higher revenue from sale of machining chips

**Location:** Energypac Ltd., Bangladesh

**Process:** Metal sheet fabrication

### Before

- Machining chips were scattered across the factory floor
- Chips were mixed with dust and other particles
- Lower sale price was obtained for dirty chips



### After

- Secondary catchment trays installed under all the machines producing metal chips
- These chips are now cleaner and easier to collect for selling at higher price



### Costs/benefits

**Cost:** BDT 3,000

**Payback:** 10 months

**Benefits:** Segregated scraps and chips selling at higher price
